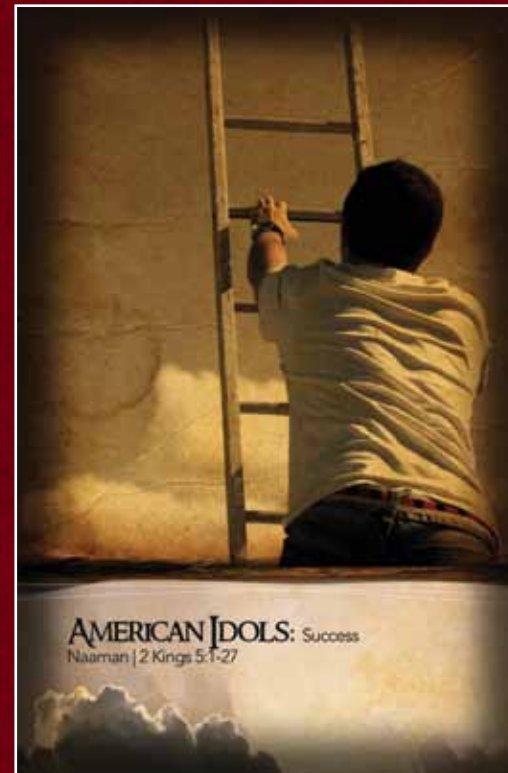
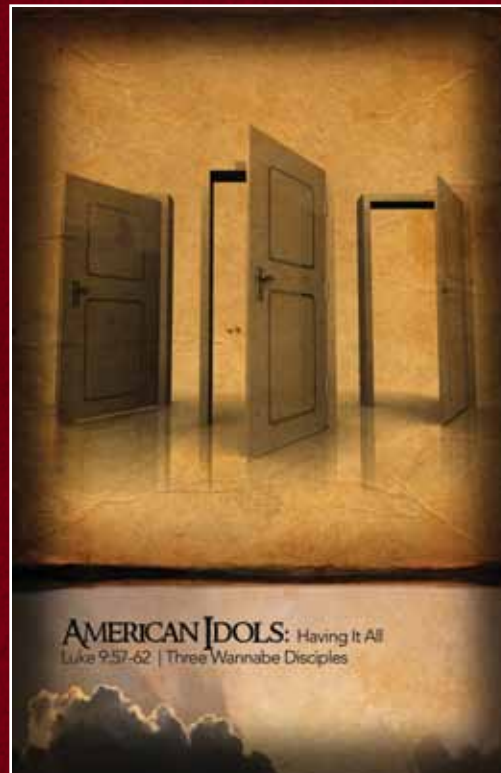
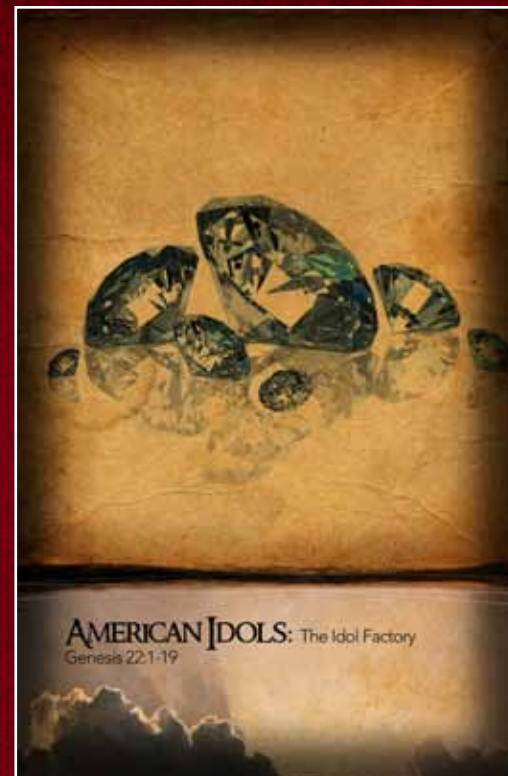
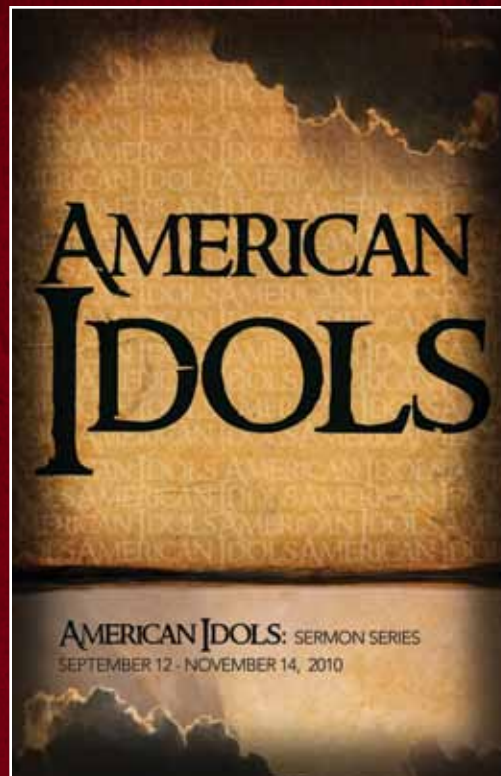
Join a Six Week American Idol Small Group!

Children and Family Ministry



Children, infants through 4th grade, Peachtree is the place for children and their families to be each Sunday morning. Children engage in programming that is age appropriate, scripture-based, relevant, and fun. Leaders serve in their area of giftedness and are equipped and passionate about sharing God's love and his word with every child. All children are welcome regardless of their special needs or other challenges. The environments are kid-friendly, engaging, and safe and secure. Relationships between children,

families, and leaders are encouraged and nurtured. Partnership between families and the church is valued and intentionally developed.

God's Little Garden
Ages 8 weeks through toddlers
Sunday Mornings 8:30 a.m. through the close of the last service



Infants are welcome in God's Little Garden at 8 weeks of age, after they have received their 8-week shots. Children are assigned to, and move through, rooms based on their developmental milestones (infants, crawlers, walkers) until they are toddlers. Toddlers are assigned to a classroom with other children just their age and remain in that classroom until moving to The Pond (the fall after they turn 2-years-old.)

In all of our rooms, we nurture the children physically, emotionally, and spiritually. The children learn about God's love for them through their interactions with caregivers, Bible stories, songs, and age-appropriate fun activities designed just for little ones. Our staff understands the special nurturing each child needs and strives to see that each child feels and understands Jesus' love for him/her.

The Pond
Ages 2 (prior to September 1) through kindergarteners.
Open during the 8:45 am, 10:00 a.m., and 11:00 a.m. hours.

Children, ages 2 (prior to September 1) through those enrolled in kindergarten or pre-first, are assigned to classes with children of the same age and remain with this group of children from year to year. During their kindergarten year, children transition to KidJam, our elementary program.

In our 2's, 3's, 4's, and 5/6 classes, children experience God's love through relationships with their leaders and peers and explore God's word through a variety of experiences and activities designed especially for preschoolers. During the 10:00 hour, children and leaders participate in Pond Time, a large group time of praise, prayer, and a visit with the Pond Pals puppet friends.

Three basic truths are emphasized:

- 1) God made me.
- 2) God loves me.
- 3) Jesus wants to be my friend forever.

Our kindergarten classes utilize a custom-designed program designed to prepare them to participate in corporate worship, explore scripture on their own, and experience some of the basics of our faith. During the 10:00 hour, children and leaders participate in Ms. Potter's Tool Time, a large group time of praise, prayer, and teaching, on some Sundays and in the worship service other Sundays.

Women Mentoring Women Takes Flight!

Grab your luggage and begin boarding. You're going on an adventure that will enrich and energize your life; maybe forever. We are now ready for take off! This is basically the trip women from Peachtree started taking as a new ministry, Women Mentoring Women, 'took off' in late January, 2010.

Both mentor and mentoree have been on this trip with basically the same thing: Bible, a Christian book, or some general topics they wanted to discuss. Their objective: developing a spiritual friendship with Christ at the center. Their destination: following God's lead for their lives.

Let's check in on some of the feedback:

Mentoree: I like having someone special in my life to discuss my faith and relationship with God. I think it's great to have a designated person to feel safe to discuss these things with.

Mentor: I still have a lump in my throat at the amazing way God works...my mentoree's bold step to reach out for guidance...the path that God has put us on together...the spiritual growth that both of us will gain.

Women Mentoring Women is all about a spiritual journey in which women who are mature in their faith (mentors) walk alongside those who are on the journey (mentorees) to listen, encourage, share their experiences, their joys and challenges, and lessons learned.

Mentoring pairs meet on a monthly basis (or bi-monthly) and plan their time together around the expressed needs of the mentoree. The time spent could mean informal conversation, prayer, studying scripture or a Christian book. By purposefully placing God at the center, through a mentoring friendship, both the mentor and mentoree grow from the experience.

Women's Community Bible Study Celebrates 20 years of Ministry

This month 14 women from around the Southeast will fly to Atlanta and come to Peachtree Presbyterian church for a special celebration. They are the original 14 who gathered in the parlor of Peachtree exactly 20 years ago to begin the new Disciple Bible Study Course led by Nancy McGuirk. When Nancy began teaching this group in 1990, she had no idea the birth of an even greater community was about to begin.

In her two years of teaching her group of 14, Nancy had developed a waiting list for the study and felt God's call to open it to others. She asked Peachtree to let her begin a community Bible study for women of all denominations and ages, and to let her host it at the church. The first day the doors were open, 85 women joined. Today, WCBS welcomes over 500 women each Wednesday morning.
